IA04 map 4: T3S, R8E S 19, S 30



That report noted that:


On April 5, 1913, the applicant made application for these lands [IF04] as an Indian Allotment, she being a half blood Indian. On April 30, 1913, she married Willie Hoaglin whose post office address is Hoaglin, California. Willie Hoaglin is also a half breed Indian and has exercised his rights under the Indian Allotment laws. The land involved in his Indian Claim are described as follows E1/2 SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec 19, NE NW and NW NE Section 30 T3S, R8E.

Due to problems with the original GLO survey the plotting of the tract is approximate.

This tract is plotted on the Base Map as a 320 acre tract as the 1915 TNF map shows that tract as being owned by Hoaglin. It is appears that like YellowJacket and his wife; two contiguous tracts were acquired as IAs by members of the Hoaglin family. The individual who applied for the second tract remains to be identified.
