
M. Willburn Indian Allotment

IA11 Map 2: T2S, R7E, S2 and S27

This tract may have been entered under the name of Mary Willburn who was the daughter of James S. Willburn (Jr.). Another daughter—Maude—acquired IA03 so by process of elimination it appears this would have been in Mary Willburn's name.

What is clear is that like tract IA10, this entry was made in the name of James Willburn's daughter in an effort by the extended Willburn family to increase their property holding in the Hettenshaw Valley area.



This tract was acquired sometime after 1894 as the area is shown as "unsurveyed on Lowden's 1894 map (A2: 05). The property lines of this tract and that of the Willburn tract in Hettenshaw Valley are plotted on the Base Map based on the 1915 TNF map and the 7.5' USGS map. As is usual for this area—given the problems with the original GLO surveys--the Section lines and property lines have been moved over the years.

The tract still shows up as private on the 1977 SRNF.
